**Reasons for the decision**

With a petition filed on January 20, 2023, the petitioners convened the Ministry of the Interior in court to obtain an appropriate order for the recognition of Italian citizenship,

They have proven their right to obtain, through administrative means, the recognition of Italian citizenship by proving the uninterrupted possession of Italian citizenship status as descendants IN THE MALE LINE of an Italian citizen by birth

The petitioners could have submitted the application to the Italian Consulate in San Francisco (USA), which is competent for the place where they reside, for the recognition of their Italian citizenship status iure sanguinis, as direct descendants of an Italian citizen, given the abnormal waiting times. However, they decided to approach the ordinary judicial authority directly, given the impossibility of obtaining such recognition within the time limits set by law.

Therefore, the petition must be accepted, declaring the petitioners Italian citizens and ordering the Ministry of the Interior to take the consequent measures.
